As a unified movement across Australian cricket one consistent act encouraged for all clubs across the country on that day is for both teams and umpires to form a pre-match

to demonstrate your commitment to Reconciliation between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and non-Indigenous Australian. Each individual is to place their hands on the backs of those next to them as a sign of support and a commitment to walk together toward Reconciliation.

1. Connect with Traditional owners and organising a Welcome to Country.
2. Do an acknowledgement to country during your barefoot circle.
3. Connect with a local Indigenous artist and paint your stumps or add elements to your uniform.
4. Unveil a plaque or sign to acknowledge the traditional owners of the land in which your ground is located on.
