



Notice of Charge: 'Not 1' Form

This Notice of Charge represents formal notification that the person named below has been charged with an offence under the Cricket Australia Code of Conduct (CoC).

ADVICE TO PLAYER OR PLAYER SUPPORT PERSONNEL – PLEASE READ:

1. You have the right to:
 - (a) admit the offence and accept the proposed sanction (no hearing required);
 - (b) admit the offence but dispute the proposed sanction (hearing required, see Section 2); or
 - (c) deny the offence and contest the charge (hearing required, see Section 2).

If you are found guilty of a second or further Code of Conduct offence within 18 months, then you may incur a more severe sanction.

2. You may:
 - (a) seek advice in respect of this Notice of Charge;
 - (b) seek representation in respect of any hearing; and
 - (c) seek a reasonable extension of time to respond to this Notice of Charge to seek advice and/or representation.

By way of guidance, a reasonable extension of time is generally considered to be:

- (a) for day matches (eg. Sheffield Shield, JLT Cup, WNCL, WBBL day matches, BBL day matches), 5 hours following the end of day's play; and
- (b) for day-night matches (eg. W/BBL night matches), 9am the following day (subject always to the availability of all participants required for the hearing).

3. Any non-compliance to respond to this Notice of Charge or any extension of time, unless there are extenuating circumstances, shall not prevent the Match Referee or Commissioner from proceeding with the hearing in your absence, provided that the Match Referee has made reasonable enquiries as to why there is no response.
